- Our general visiting hours for rehabilitation patients are from 3 to 8pm daily.
- Visiting time for palliative care patients is BY ARRANGEMENT.

### How has our Inpatient & Day Rehabilitation programs adapted to COVID-19?

Our Rehabilitation service has strict precautions in place so we can help your patient's recovery and independence with our extensive programs.

For example, patients following a post-acute cardiac event or cardiac surgery, such as Stents, Bypass or Valve surgery benefit greatly from Rehab. They may come to the Inpatient Heart Wellness Program first and then transition to the Day Rehabilitation or come directly from home to Day Rehabilitation.

Telehealth consultations for Day Rehabilitation / Outpatients are available and patients can call us to discuss their options. They do require a Doctors referral.
